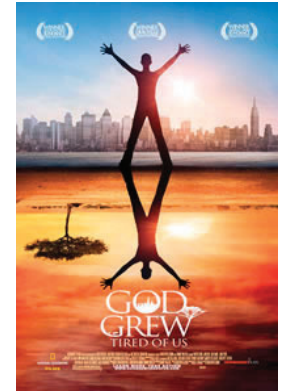

## *About John Dau*

National Geographic writes, "Dau is one of the thousands of African males in Southern Sudan attacked in the 1980s and '90s by the Arab Sudanese government in the north. For 16 years, Dau was either on the run—from the Arab militia and the Sudanese Army, from wild animals, from starvation and thirst—or living in refugee camps." After being featured in the award-winning film, *God Grew Tired Of Us*, lost boy John Dau decided to devote his celebrity to the cause of bringing hope and security to the Sudanese people.

John's story is told in his book entitled *God Grew Tired of Us: A Memoir* published by National Geographic.
